

REGIONAL / NATIONAL CONFERENCES FACT SHEET

Two regional conferences and one national conference are held each year. The Annual Planning Conference is a regional, one day event typically held in October or November on a Saturday. This is an opportunity for newly elected officers and all members to plan the new year. Workshops focus on officer job descriptions and committee functions. Forum is a regional, spring conference where the region's chapters come together for a three day event full of educational and networking opportunities via keynote speakers and workshops. Convention is the annual, national conference of NAWIC typically held each September. NAWIC members from the United States and Canada, international affiliates and event sponsors come together for this event. The conference consists of four days of keynote speakers, professional workshops and association workshops. Installation of national officers and directors also take place. In 2009, the Annual Planning Conference was held in Columbus, Ohio, Forum was held in Lexington, Kentucky and Convention was held in Phoenix, Arizona.
