State Architect with ODAS, Lane Beougher, AIA, FCSI, LEED AP BD+C

Lane J. Beougher, was appointed state architect on June 2, 2011, after serving five months on an interim basis. Lane joined the State Architect's Office (SAO) in 2005, most recently as Program Services Manager, and led the Energy Services team from April 2007 through September 2009. Prior to coming to SAO, Lane accumulated 25 years of facilities planning, architectural design, specifications preparation, and construction administration experience. Prior to his public sector experience, he was an associate and senior project architect with the Columbus office of Braun & Steidl Architects, an AIA Ohio Gold Medal firm, and graduated from The Ohio State University with a bachelor of science in architecture. Lane is a member of the American Institute of Architects, a former president of its Columbus Chapter, and currently serves as its delegate to the AIA Ohio Board and is vice chair of the national Public Architects Committee. A Fellow of the Construction Specifications Institute, Lane serves on the national Board of Directors as its Secretary. He is also a LEED Accredited Professional and has been involved in sustainable design and construction strategies since 1996.
